## Entry Fees

\$20 for the first entry/\$15 for the second additional entry/ \$12 for the third additional entry of each dog each day (entry fees include \$3/dog per day per entry AKC recording fee). **Per AKC rules, entries must include the Agreement on the back of the entry form.** Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Returned checks will be assessed a \$25 returned check charge. All entries must be submitted on the official AKC agility entry form, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. (AKC Rule CH14, Sec 4). Faxed or on-line entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Please waive signature on FedEx or UPS mail.

## Refunds

Request for withdrawal of entry must be made in writing or via email to the trial secretary. There are no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, there will be no refund regardless of the reason for dismissal. No entry fee will be returned if this event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete and may be withdrawn with full refund until the trial closes. After closing, there is a 50% refund (less applicable AKC and judges' fees) up to the Friday preceding the trial.

## Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class as a result of completing a title. Move-up requests prior to the trial must be received via writing or email to the Secretary by 6PM of the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move-ups will be allowed for dogs completing a title on Saturday. A form must be filled out and presented to the Trial Secretary within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course at the end of the trial on Saturday.

## Ribbons, Awards and Participation Gift

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height. All dogs receiving a qualifying score will be awarded a green qualifying ribbon. Excellent B dogs qualifying in both Standard and JWW on the same day will be awarded a Double Q rosette. Dogs completing a MACH or PAX title will be awarded a MACH or PAX rosette. Dogs completing a title at these trials will be awarded a MBDTc medallion. A dog toy participation gift (\$3-\$8 value) will be presented to each exhibitor entered in the trial. Awards will not be mailed or delivered.

## AKC Jump Height Policy

All dogs competing in agility must present a valid AKC jump height card with entry, at check-in, or be measured prior to competing. Any dog that does not have an AKC jump height card may still compete at these trials but must be measured at the trial prior to running. The judge of record for these trials, or an AKC measuring official, if present, will do measuring of dogs. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

Classes offered are Regular Titling for Standard, JWW, and FAST – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B; Preferred Titling for Standard, JWW, and FAST – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B; JWW - Novice A & B, Open, and Excellent A & B.

## Course Familiarization

Handlers will be permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age and over that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an ILP or PAL number from the AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Please **TYPE** or **CLEARLY PRINT** all information on the entry form. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry. Per AKC rules, entries must include the Agreement on the back of the entry form. Any entries that do not include the agreement cannot be accepted and will be returned.
- The Club and Management will attempt to exercise every precaution for the safety of all dogs and people; however, neither the Club nor the Management will be responsible for any injury or loss.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. This is a SELF CLEANING SHOW. Please bring necessary supplies and clean up after your dogs. Dogs must be on a leash except when in the ring.
- Handlers must wear shoes while in the ring. No barefoot handler runs will be allowed.
- There is NO shade near the rings. Please bring shade and water for yourself and your dogs.
- Complementary coffee and pastries will be available each morning for exhibitors.
- With an abundance of restaurants and grocery stores nearby, no food will be sold on site. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the grounds.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
